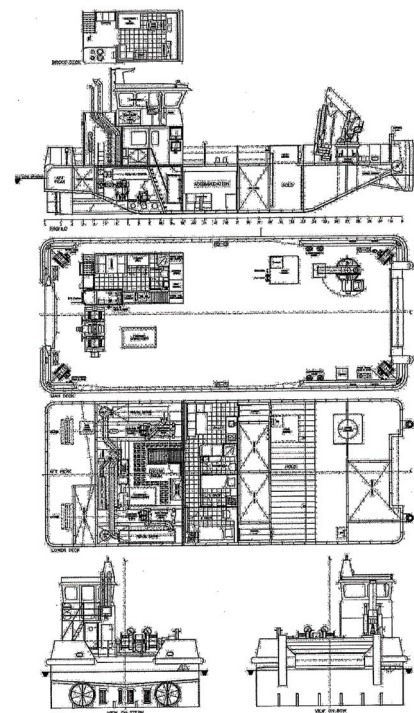




## Laura M Multi-Role Vessel

The Laura M has the reputation of being one of the strongest and most versatile vessels in the sector. Her layout maximises her capabilities beyond that expected of her 20 metre platform. Her wheelhouse and deck equipment are all situated as far aft as is possible to provide a large clear working area. Her deck easily accepts a 40 ft container or 20 ft storage with an 18 ft temporary site office.
