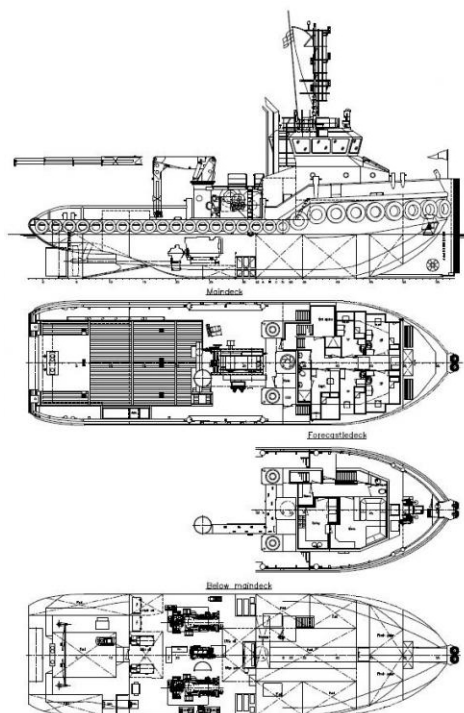




Liz F Shoalbuster 3209
